Rainfall: After the spring drought June was a wet month with about a third more rain than average. It was still insufficient to offset the earlier drought though. July started dry but then became damp in the middle of the month.

Temperatures: June was slightly warmer than average at least during the day due to short glimpses of a real summer with hot spells at the start and end of the month but overall not much opportunity to dine outside.

Weather elsewhere:

In common with Southern England the drought in the rest of central and western continental Europe has continued and in Germany the forest fire danger index has reached its highest level an ominous sign for later in the summer. In contrast our travels in Canada revealed high snowfall last winter and high rain amounts over the Rockies with a late spring.
