Rainfall: October was about 15% drier than average and November has started a bit wetter than average but nothing too dramatic locally.

Temperatures: October had a head start with record warm temperatures during the first few weeks and continued with average temperatures so overall a very warm month. Some of our plants were getting very confused with the glimpse of a second summer. November continues the warmer trend being over 3degC warmer than average. There are premature suggestions this could be another record breaking warm month – see next month's report. Some parts of the media have been suggesting it will be another cold winter but there is no evidence for this.

Weather elsewhere:

Bangkok did get flooded as you will have seen in the news. Taiwan has been deluged with unseasonable rains. It is the end of the hurricane season on 30 Nov and this year there were 6 of which the most famous was Irene which battered both the Caribbean and New York.
